# **Eligibility**

- Successfully pass the CPSD™ Exam.
- Successfully pass Exam 1 Foundation of Supply Management of the Certified Professional in Supply Management® (CPSM®) . This requirement is waived if the candidate holds a current CPSM® or C.P.M.
- Minimum of five years of professional (nonclerical, nonsupport) supplier diversity or supply management
  experience (does not need to be primary function), OR three years of professional (nonclerical, nonsupport) supplier diversity or supply management experience IF the candidate has a bachelor's degree from
  a regionally accredited college or university (or international equivalent).

Recertify every three years with 60 Continuing Education Hours (CEHs). ISM offers many options, including online courses, to earn CEHs. Most employer training, job-related conferences and college courses are also eligible for CEHs.

# **How to Prepare for the CPSD™ Exams**

Set your goals and create a time line to study and take your CPSD $^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam and either CPSM $^{\mathbb{G}}$  Exam 1 (Current CPSM $^{\mathbb{G}}$ s or C.P.M.s only take CPSD $^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam). We recommend you start with CPSM $^{\mathbb{G}}$  Exam 1 as it helps you be more prepared for the CPSD $^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam. Then, register and schedule your exam.

Take the CPSM® Diagnostic Kit Exam 1 practice test to find your weak areas. Use your score report from the Diagnostic Kit to develop a study plan to target areas you need to strengthen — areas in which you scored less than 75 percent. The diagnostic score report references where to find the explanations in the CPSM® Study Guide, the ISM Professional Series and a few other resources. If you find you need more help, take a CPSM® Exam 1 Review Course available in online and self-study workbook formats.

As needed, adjust your goals and time line for the  $CPSD^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam. Then, register and schedule your exam. Take the  $CPSD^{\mathbb{M}}$  Online Exam Review Course or complete the  $CPSD^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam Review Self-Study Workbook (same content). ISM and some of its affiliates periodically offer a face-to-face  $CPSD^{\mathbb{M}}$  Exam Review Course (content similar to online and workbook).
