Prior to joining AFP in 2003, Derry was with LexisNexis Group in Dayton, Ohio.

PRESENT YOUR RESEARCH AT THE 2013 NORTH AMERICAN RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM

Are you looking for a way to get the word out on your current research project or research results? Submit a proposal to present at the **23rd Annual North American Research Symposium on Purchasing and Supply Chain Management**.

Abstracts and session proposals for the symposium will be accepted **Monday, September 17 through Friday, October 19, 2012**.

The symposium is scheduled for **March 14-15, 2013 at the Phoenix/Chandler Hilton in Chandler, Arizona**. This is a unique forum for both academicians and practitioners to interact by sharing ideas, including innovative programs and completed research in the supply management field. The symposium agenda features addresses by senior business leaders, provocative panel discussions, presentations of competitively selected original research papers, sessions on instructional techniques and material, and time for discussion and collaboration.

Abstract and proposal submissions are accepted in the five categories: (1) competitive proposals, (2), working papers, (3) symposium session proposals, (4) practitioner papers, and (5) teaching cases. Refer to the [symposium page](#) on the ISM website for details on how to submit an abstract or proposal.

The submissions undergo a blind review process, and the papers are chosen on appropriateness of their topic for presentation at the symposium, organization of the information (logical flow of ideas), theoretical soundness, research methodology, and contribution to research or instruction. Authors of accepted papers will be notified in mid-December 2012, and final papers are due February 1, 2013.

CAPS Research grants research scholarships of \$900 to up to 25 junior faculty members or current doctoral students to support participation in the North American Research Symposium on Supply Chain Management. Scholarship winners must submit a paper for the *Proceedings*, attend the entire symposium, and present a paper. UPDATE: 2012 ACADEMIC RESEARCH SUPPORT PROGRAM GRANTS

At its May 2012 meeting, the ISM Board of Directors approved and recommended a slate of recipients for grants to be awarded under the ISM Academic Research Support Program. The recipients have been notified, and they will be publicly announced in September 2012.

The goal of the Academic Research Support Program is to increase academic leadership and assist more advanced students to enter the supply management profession. Grants are offered in four phases, reaching supply management academics at various points in their careers:

Grant Phase	Recipients
Phase 1: The ISM Dissertation Research Grant	doctoral students
Phase 2: The Professional Research Development Grant	assistant and younger associate professors
Phase 3: The ISM Professional Research and Collaboration Grant	associate and new full professors
Phase 4: The ISM Distinguished Leadership Grant	senior full professors
