ISM 2013 ACADEMIC RESEARCH SUPPORT PROGRAM - DOCTORAL GRANTS

Institute for Supply Management[™] (ISM) is accepting applications in its Academic Research Support Program for Dissertation Research Grants (Phase 1 of the Academic Research Support Program). Completed application packets are due by January 31, 2013. For 2013, grants will not be offered for Phases 2, 3 and 4.

The long-running ISM Dissertation Grant Program encourages doctoral students interested in supply management to develop and complete their dissertation research in supply management or closely related topics. For 2013, ISM intends to support up to four dissertations at up to US\$12,000 each. Each recipient has three years from the date of the award to complete their dissertation.

CAPS Research is offering up to 25 scholarships at \$900 US dollars each for doctoral students and junior faculty members (defined as instructors or assistant professors with terminal degrees and up to 5 years in rank without tenure) to support participation at the Symposium. To apply for a scholarship, email your request with a letter from your department chair verifying your status within the department. **The due date for submission of requests is February 1, 2013.**

Scholarship recipients must submit a document for the *Proceedings*, present their paper at the symposium and attend the full Research Symposium on Purchasing and Supply Chain Management, March 14–15, 2013. Notification of scholarship awards will be made prior to the Symposium. Scholarship payment will be made after the Symposium.
