Be among the first and participate in CPSM Pilot Testing. Pilot testing will be offered through ISM affiliates and participating companies in February and March of 2008. All supply management professionals who want to

achieve the CPSM are welcome to participate in the CPSM Pilot Testing Program. Keep in mind that the CPSM Bridge Exam will not be offered during the pilot testing period.

CPSM Eligibility

The criteria for earning the CPSM qualification are:

- 5 years of full-time, professional, non-clerical, nonsupport supply management experience
- 4-year degree from a regionally accredited college or university
 If your degree was earned from an institution outside the United States, it will need
 to be evaluated for U.S. regional equivalency before submitting your CPSM
 application. ISM recommends that applicants use the services of Educational
 Credential Evaluators at www.ece.org/. The "general" evaluation is all that ISM
 requires. The cost of the evaluation is the responsibility of the applicant.
- Pass the three CPSM Exams OR, if you are a C.P.M. in good standing, pass the Bridge Exam that will be available in May 2008, at the ISM International Conference in St. Louis.

Sponsor CPSM Pilot Testing

Be a part of the new era in supply management by having your company or ISM affiliate sponsor CPSM Pilot Testing this next February and March 2008. Affiliates and companies must have at least five exams to test (individuals may take multiple exams) in order to register for the pilot program.

The New Era of Global Supply Management Approaches

As we near the debut of the Certified Professional in Supply Management (CPSM) qualification, it's important to keep in mind why ISM decided to create the CPSM. The world

is changing. Over the last several decades, trade, growing market economies and the scope of medium and large multinational enterprises have broadened the profession's responsibilities.

Increasingly, suppliers are positioned to take advantage of economies of scale, many times located in far corners of the globe. Additionally, managers face challenges in technology, regulation, logistics and competition. This has resulted in such a dramatic change in the supply management landscape that



demand for the skills represented in the CPSM have made its development critical, even mandatory for the continued expansion of professional capabilities.

ISM exists to lead supply management. As the responsibilities of supply managers have grown, so has the need to prepare supply management professionals for the responsibility they hold. The CPSM represents the profession's progress, expansion and growth — the next level in the profession's evolution. Supply managers who dare to lead in this effort will require courage, stamina and persistence in the face of the unknown.

Microsoft's Bill Gates had these qualities. He dared to lead in an industry when hardware, not software, had more emphasis. In 1985, after IBM refused to purchase Microsoft, the first Windows version 1.0 hit the stores — and flopped. This, however, did not deter Gates.



His courage and persistence in the face of the unknown paid off. Windows 2.0 was released in 1987, which saw better acceptance. Then, Windows 3.0 was realized, creating Microsoft's first true success.

With headstrong determination and a vision for success, Debbi Fields, a young mother with no business experience, opened her first cookie store in Palo Alto, California, in 1977. They told her she was

crazy. No business could survive just selling cookies. Humble beginnings launched Mrs. Fields into a worldwide celebrity and made her company the premier chain of cookie and baked goods stores.

"The important thing is not being afraid to take a chance." Fields said. "Remember, the greatest failure is to not try. Once you find something you love to do, be the best at doing it."

This kind of determination was also exemplified by Pierre Omidyar, who in 1995 created a small Web site called AuctionWeb. At the time, eBay was just one part of AuctionWeb's domain. Again, Omidyar's persistence in the face of the unknown paid dividends. By 1997, the company was a huge success, changing its name to eBay.

In this new supply management era, the CPSM shows great promise to those who invest in its potential. Professionals who commit to earning the CPSM must have courage and persistence in the face this challenge. They must Dare to Lead.

The CPSM Bridge Exam: What C.P.M.s Should Know



Subject matter on the CPSM Bridge Exam has been updated to reflect the most current professional information and best practices. Candidates wishing to bridge from the C.P.M. should also be up-to-date.
